have made it a winner. But manufacturers are often slow to respond.

What if Norton had adopted the French “Nougier” four cylinder engine, or in fact developed their own “four” that they were considering in the 1950’s. Would they have

continued to produce the single-cylinder "Manx" for sale to the privateers, or, like MV Agusta, run four-cylinder "works" entries but offer nothing to the clubman rider? Incidentally, the Mc Candless brothers designed their "Featherbed" frame to be adaptable to many different engines, not just Norton's venerable single cylinder unit. Bracebridge St. did produce many twins within its framework, but that was it.

And what of Triumph? As the most popular sporting roadsters of the 1950's, why

didn't they stem some of the BSA Gold Star's glory in events like the Clubmans TT?

Finally, what if Mr. Honda had actually produced, from 1962, a 500cc twin-cylinder racer as created by Gerry Kooistra and others? That would have rocked the boat, and maybe the results of many events would have looked quite different.
