Sadly, we are losing our long-term Editor in Les Bell. Les, everyone thanks you for the great job you have done, recently under very difficult circumstances. I hope this gives you a little extra time to get things back on track, and that you can attend the AGM for an official "Thank You".

With the use of electronic payments and the difficulty in finding a willing Auditor, we find ourselves needing to fine tune the Constitution in a couple of areas. I have proposed the following alterations, supported by Danny Ahern, Chris Hayward, Dean & Neil Watson & Stuart Penn. They shall be tabled & debated at this, the July General Meeting, & voted on at next month's AGM.

They are: Rule 15: Expenditure. Point 4 reads "Payment of accounts will be made by cheque, requiring the signatures of two Committee members"

Suggested amendment is to add "or by electronic Transfer of Funds", so it reads "Payment of accounts will be made by cheque, requiring the signatures of two Committee members, or by electronic Transfer of Funds'.

Point 6 reads "Audited balance sheets shall be submitted to the Annual General Meeting by the Treasurer". Suggested amendment is to remove "audited", so it now reads "Balance sheets shall be submitted to the Annual General Meeting by the Treasurer".

Rule 17: Inspection of Books. Point 2 reads "The financial records of the Club shall be audited once annually by a person or persons appointed by the Committee". Suggested amendment is to replace "shall" with "may", so it now reads "The financial records of the Club may be audited once annually by a person or persons appointed by the Committee ".

I hope you all agree with these adjustments, which will assist the Committee Members greatly.

Our Vice- President has planned another Mallala Ride Day on Friday 27th September, again with the Ducati Owners' Club. Format will be much the same as last time, with a bit of fine tuning in some areas. After the encouraging turnout last time, we hope for even more riders.
