ANNOUNCEMENT: The Historic Motor Cycle Racing Register SA Inc, hereafter called the PROMOTER, will conduct The Barossa Vintage Hillclimb Historic periods 1, 2, & 3, SOLO, SIDECAR AND CYCLECARS at the COLLINGROVE HILLCLIMB CIRCUIT, 8KMS SOUTH OF ANGASTONON THE EDEN VALLEY ROAD, on SUN 2ND OCT 2022</p>		
<p>2. JURISDICTION:</p> <p>2.1. The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling SA Inc. which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number RR/22/C/00148 and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia Senior National Licences and Senior One Meeting National Licences.</p> <p>2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport, these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling SA Inc. BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.</p>		
<p>3. ENTRIES:</p> <p>3.1. Entries open forthwith and close last mail WEDNESDAY 14TH SEPTEMBER 2022. Preferably fill in entry and email to Competition secretary or send entries to the Competition Secretary at the above address</p> <p>3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Club or Promoter, whichever is applicable, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.</p> <p>3.3. Only entries received on the official entry form and accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.</p> <p>3.4. NOTE:- LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CLUB OR PROMOTER, WHICHEVER IS APPLICABLE.</p>		
<p>4. INSURANCE:</p> <p>4.1. The National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.</p> <p>4.2. Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.</p>

5. **MEDICAL SERVICES:**
The Ambulance Service will be in attendance at all times during timed runs.
- 6 **ENTRY FEE:**
- 6.1. Entry fees are detailed on the official entry form attached.
- 6.2. Payment by EFT, cheque or money order. **ANY FEES FOR DISHONoured CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT.**

- 7 **ENTRY PASSES:**
2 passes per entry (3 per sidecar) plus one vehicle pass. Participants quoting a current Entrants Licence receive one extra pass.
- 8 **PROPOSED CATEGORIES OF COMPETITION:** Periods 1,2 & 3 SOLO, SIDECAR AND CYCLECARS
- 9 **AWARDS:**
Trophies will be awarded to the fastest competitors in each category, which has a minimum of 3 competitors
- 10 **ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:**
- 10.1. Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards will be at the discretion of the club or promoter, whichever is applicable, subject to Motorcycling SA Inc. approval.
- 11 **RACE FORMAT:**
All runs will be timed, with the individual's fastest time being recorded for awards., then racing
- 12 **MACHINES AND RIDERS:**
- 12.1. All machines entered must comply with the current MOMS for competition.
- 12.2. Multiple entries of the one machine in the same class of competition are not permitted.
- 12.3. Riders must present themselves at scrutineering **wearing appropriate riding gear** and must present current MA Competition Licences
- **A separate unique number is required for each machine, to enable the timing equipment to identify each machine**
- 12.4. A change of rider is permitted with prior written approval of the Clerk of Course a minimum of 30 mins before the contested event.
- 13 **RUN ORDER:**
Run starting positions will be determined by numeric ascending order.
- 14 **RIDERS' BRIEFING:**
A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing; **ALL COMPETITORS MUST ATTEND** and sign the attendance record. No competitor will be permitted to race if they have not signed the competitors' briefing list.
- 15 **DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:**
- 15.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA and MSA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy and Motorcycling SA Drug and Alcohol Policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.
- 15.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the confirmation of awards may be delayed at the discretion of Motorcycling SA Inc. until the results of the tests are known.

16 CODE OF CONDUCT:

All competitors, and officials are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

18 CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

Timed runs to be conducted on a sealed surface (track) Of 685metres in length.

19 STARTS:

All runs will be clutch start. Starting will be by, RED – prepare to start, GREEN LIGHT ON – for start at rider’s discretion.

20 NOISE:

Where conducted, noise limits will be applied as per GCR’s rule 12.10.

21 SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

21.1 Pit enclosure – The pit enclosure is a walking pace riding area, except for the bitumen exit road.
